Two-Day Outing to Co. Donegal Narrow Gauge Railways

The Society has arranged a two-day outing to visit the Narrow Gauge Railways of Co. Donegal on Friday 20th and Saturday 21st July 2018. We will travel from Dublin to Derry (via Belfast) by service train. A Coach will take us to the **Foyle Valley Railway Museum** before heading to the **Fintown Railway** in Co. Donegal. Overnight accommodation will be at **Dillon's Hotel**, **Letterkenny**. On Saturday we will visit the **Difflin Lake Railway** and Gardens at Oakfield Park in Raphoe (**lunch included**). The coach will then bring us to Derry Station to return to Dublin by service train.

- Admission to the Foyle Valley Railway Museum, Fintown Railway and Difflin Lake Railway & Gardens
- Overnight accommodation (bed & breakfast) at Dillon's Hotel, Letterkenny (per person sharing basis)

Other Information:

<u>Meal arrangements</u>: The main meal of the day on Friday will be the 4-course dinner at Dillon's Hotel that evening. As a result, **there will be no scheduled lunch stop**, as would be the case on other outings. Therefore **please ensure to purchase food on the Enterprise or at Belfast Central Station**, where we will have approximately 30 minutes to wait for the onward connection to Derry (subject to no delays etc). There will be no further opportunity to purchase food after this point until arriving at the hotel that evening.

Breakfast is included at the hotel on Saturday morning and we will also have a lunch stop at "Buffers" restaurant at the Difflin Lake Railway & Oakfield Gardens.

<u>Difflin Lake Railway</u>: The railway have advised us that the steam locomotive, "the Duchess of Difflin" will be used on the train especially for our visit on the Saturday morning (subject to availability); normally it is operational only one Sunday a month, with all other services being hauled by a diesel locomotive.

Admission is also included to explore the extensive Oakfield Gardens, where the Difflin Lake Railway is situated and ample time has been included in the itinerary for this purpose.
